Resolution on the statement by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine "On Repulsion to Armed Russian Aggression and Overcoming its consequences".

2297-1

Legalises gathering charitable donations by means of SMS-messages.

Frees from taxation all charity donations, gathered by means of SMS-messages.

2423

Harmonizes Ukrainian anti-tobacco legislation with Resolution of the EU.

2430

Provides an ability to receive information about real estate and land owners freely and conveniently.

2431

Establishes common principles of charging penalties by anti-monopoly bodies and filing appeals.

NATIONAL COUNCIL OF REFORMS

Preparation to the International Conference which is to be held in Kyiv on 28th of April.

Held a meeting with a delegation of Northern Europe and Baltic Parliaments Chairpersons.

Held meetings with Ambassadors and Representatives of Saudi Arabia, Iraq, Poland, the Kingdom of Morocco, the Republic of Turkey, Hungary, Romania, South-African Republic, Austria, Australia, Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, Norway, Great Britain, Japan, France.

Participated in the German Marshall Fund's Brussels Forum.

Ensured working visit of Romanian parliamentary delegation consisting of the Chairman of the Commission on external policy of the Romanian parliament's Chamber of Deputies László Borbély

Met with Hungarian parliament's Chairperson of the Committee on Foreign Affairs during his visit to Kyiv.

Fostered cooperation with Sweden by holding a meeting of Ukrainian and Swedish MPs in Stockholm.
