PROTOCOL
on amendments to the Charter
of the Organization for Democracy and Economic Development – GUAM

Member States of the Organization for Democracy and Economic Development – GUAM
guided by the goals and principles of cooperation, enshrined in the Charter of the
Organization for Democracy and Economic Development – GUAM, aimed at developing
comprehensive political, economic and humanitarian cooperation, ensuring sustainable development
and security of the region,

seeking to further deepen the sectoral cooperation of the Member States, especially its
economic component, and taking into account the positive impact of the meetings of the Heads of
Government on the implementation of multilateral projects and programs,

bearing in mind the constitutional changes that have taken place in Member States,
acting in accordance with Article 21 of the Charter,

AGREED as follows:

1. Paragraph 2 of Article 3 shall be worded as follows: "The Council is the main body of
the Organization that conducts its work at the level of Heads of State and Government (Summit),
Ministers of Foreign Affairs, National coordinators and Permanent representatives."

2. Instead in articles 4, 5, 6, 13, 14 and 20 the words "Council of Heads of State" and
the derivative abbreviation "CHS" with "Council of Heads of State and Government" and "CHSG",
respectively.

3. Disputes regarding the application and interpretation of this Protocol shall be resolved
through negotiations and consultations.

4. This Protocol is an integral part of the Charter of the Organization for Democracy and
Economic Development – GUAM.

5. This Protocol shall enter into force in accordance with Article 19 of the Charter of the
Organization for Democracy and Economic Development – GUAM.

6. The Secretariat is the depositary of the Protocol, which will send a certified copy to
each party.
